Priority

Again we're pleased to report that over the last three month period we have had no reports of residential burglaries in the area but we have had a report of a couple of attempted shed breaks in Dawley Bank. Please keep alert and report anything suspicious on 101. In an emergency please use 999.

What have we done?

Patrols in the areas concerned and shed alarms issued to premises affected were appropriate. We will continue to patrol the areas.

We are looking to increase the number of Neighbourhood Watch schemes in the area. If you are interested in starting a scheme please contact the SNT Team or Parish Council who will pass your details on to us.



Priority

We are aware of the constant problem of speeding vehicles in the Lawley and Overdale area including, but not limited to Glendale, Dawley Road, Rock Road and Colliers Way.

We have also been made aware of parking issues on Village Drive in Lawley and by the shops in Birchfield Way.

There has been an increase in the theft of catalytic Converters from vehicles with two incidents reported in the Lawley and Overdale area

What have we done?

Speed enforcement has taken place in Colliers Way and Garfield Road. We continue to work with our Traffic Unit and Safer Roads Team to carry out further speed enforcement and for unmarked police vehicles to carry out patrols in the area.

We have carried out enforcement in the area with warning notices have been issued where required.

We are looking to increase the number of Community Speed Watch Groups in the area. Please contact us or the Parish Council if you are interested in helping us.

Please report any suspicious activity on 101 or **999 in an emergency**. Where possible please park your vehicle in a garage or well-lit area and consider CCTV opportunities when parking





Priority

As the evenings get lighter reports of off- road motorbikes including quad bikes causing a nuisance reports tend to increase.

We're also aware of reports of drug use and litter in the parks and these continue to cause concern.

What have we done?

We have carried out targeted operations in the affected areas to tackle off-road vehicles resulting in the seizing off road bikes. To report concerns for off road biking contact www.westmercia.police.uk or call 101, giving details of Registration, bike and rider description, time and location where possible. Always call 999 in an emergency.

We are working with the Parish Council and Telford and Wrekin Neighbourhood Enforcement Teams in relation to the ASB problems in our area.





Key Dates
