

# Chair's Annual Report for 2022 - 2023 Annual Parish Meeting on 16 May 2023

This is my second Annual Report as Chair of Lawley & Overdale Parish Council and what a busy year it has been.

There have been some key events and activities that have taken place over the past twelve months, from our annual Summer Fest, Lawley 5K Fun Run and our numerous Christmas celebrations.



We also celebrated the jubilee of the late Queen Elizabeth in both Overdale and Lawley, ensuring everyone who attended had fun and enjoyed themselves. Equally, we all gathered together to mark the occasion of King Charles III coronation. A true moment in history. The Bake Off demonstrated that there is clearly some talented bakers within the local community.

Working with our partners has enabled us to provide an array of activities over the holidays, from Exotic Zoo, Fun Science and even cooking lessons to name but a few. The feedback received demonstrates how well these activities were received and enables residents to try something new for free.



Our activities have not just been for children and families either. The adults Sip and Paint classes have provided very popular too, with residents homing their artistic skills and producing some fine pieces of work.

Our Tea, Toast and Talk session in Overdale has been a huge success and it has brought members of the community back together at the Carpenter Family Centre each week for some arts and crafts and on occasion a game of bingo! The centre was reopened to local residents last year and has become a welcoming hub for all.

Our Community Action Team, comprising of both Neighbourhood Enforcement Officers and our Parish Environment Operatives, have worked tirelessly across the Parish to ensure the areas are kept clean, tidy and green whilst enhancing the local environment, and reporting any problems.

There have been some new additions to the Parish area too, with the King's Coronation willow crown now situated in the Lawley Community Garden. A tranquil space for residents to enjoy, designed and commissioned by a local artist.



Newdale Park has a new play area including an outside gym and has proved popular with residents of all ages. The new facilities are a result of partnership working with the Lawley Partnership Board and Bournville Village Trust for the benefit of the whole community.

Old Park now has some new benches, enabling residents to take a seat and enjoy the beautiful views around them. In addition, the well know and used green space has been recognised as a Green Guarantee Site by Telford & Wrekin Council along with Captains Meadow at The Rock. This means that the area will not be used for any development.



Work continues on the Lawley & Overdale History Trail, which was devised in 2013, and covers every part of the Parish. Further announcements will be made on this as the Parish Council seeks to retain, share and highlight the rich history of the area.

I am pleased to announce that the Parish Council has awarded thirteen grants over the last year to local community groups, totalling nearly £6,000 and it has supported walking groups, charities and even a new line dancing group to name but a few.
